ORDER GRANTING CLASS COUNSEL'S MOTION SEEKING AN AWARD OF REASONABLE COSTS, ATTORNEYS' FEES, AND INCENTIVE AWARDS IN CONNECTION WITH THE PPG SETTLEMENT AND APPROVING MANNER OF REDISTRIBUTION OF JOINT HONEYWELL/PPG COSTS

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Class Counsel's Motion Seeking an Award of Reasonable Costs, Attorneys' Fees and Incentive Awards in Connection with the PPG Settlement is GRANTED. Accordingly, Epiq Class Action and Claims Solutions, Inc. ("Epiq") is directed to:

- 1. issue a check to the law firm of German Rubenstein LLP in the amount of \$1,250,000 for attorneys' fees;
- 2. issue a check to the law firm of German Rubenstein LLP in the amount of \$315,251.33 for reimbursement of litigation costs;
- 3. issue a check to Mattie Halley in the amount of \$10,000 as an incentive award; and
- 4. issue a check to Leticia Malave in the amount of \$10,000 as an incentive award.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Class Counsel's proposal for the pro rata allocation and reimbursement of joint litigation expenses to the Honeywell Classes (A and C) is deemed fair and reasonable. Accordingly, Epiq is directed to, within 15 days of the Effective Date, redistribute to each Class A and C property for which a valid Claim has been submitted, a pro rata portion of the \$1,085,869.58 in previously reimbursed joint Honeywell and PPG litigation expenses pursuant to the formula below:

- Step 1. \$1,085,869.58/total number of Class A, B, and C properties submitting a valid claim = amount each property *should* pay
- Step 2. \$1,085,869.58/total number of Class A and C properties that have submitted a valid Claim = amount each Class A and C property submitting a valid Claim did pay
